

WARRIOR LEADER COURSE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. To achieve course graduation requirements, the student must meet the minimum score of 70% in the below areas:

- a. Conduct Army Physical Readiness Training (PRT).
- b. Conduct Individual Training (CIT).
- c. Conduct Squad Drill.
- d. Communicate in Writing.
- e. Oral History Briefing.
- f. Two demonstrated Leadership Evaluations (garrison and tactical environment).
- g. Leadership Exam.
- h. Training Exam.
- i. Warfighting Exam.
- j. Land Navigation Evaluation (75%)

2. Students must pass the APFT and meet the Height/Weight requirements in order to graduate the Warrior Leader Course (WLC). Students will take an initial APFT and screen Height/Weight requirements and are allowed one retest. Students who fail to pass a final APFT or Height/Weight standards will be dismissed from WLC per the Secretary of the Army's Memorandum 2012-20 (Physical Fitness and Height and Weight Requirements for Professional Military Education) effective 1 November 2012.
