SUBJECT: Warrior Leader Course Policy Letter #27 - Student Conduct Policy

1. Reference. AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, 18 March 2008 (RAR005 20 September 2012).
2. Purpose. This policy provides guidance on student conduct for all Soldiers attending the Warrior Leader Course (WLC). The following activities are prohibited:
 - a. Failure to report a privately owned weapon upon arrival.
 - b. Use or possession of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.
 - c. Drunk on duty.
 - d. Violation of WLC tobacco usage guidance.
 - e. Insubordination or failure to comply with lawful orders.
 - f. Destruction of government property.
 - g. Participating in an unsafe act.
 - h. Violation of curfew or lights out (barracks personnel).
 - i. Leaving the WLC area during the duty day without permission.
 - j. Leaving the Fort Carson installation at any time without permission.
 - k. Allowing unauthorized individuals in student leaving areas (barracks personnel).
 - l. Loitering in any WLC parking lot area.
 - m. Cheating, copying, plagiarism, or any disruptive actions during the course.
3. Fraternalization is not allowed including unprofessional relationships involving student with student, student with cadre, or cadre with student.

4. Students may be released for infractions of the Honor Code, Army Ethics, WLC Policies and Procedures, or infractions of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Students may also be released for demonstrating a lack of motivation or inability to meet established course standards. Students arriving under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be denied enrollment.
5. Members of the opposite sex are not authorized in living areas in the barracks except when a Soldier is accompanied by a Small Group Leader and performing official duties.
6. Students attending WLC are restricted (Off Limits) from the following areas:
 - a. All cadre offices, unless directed by WLC cadre.
 - b. The Headquarters area, unless directed by WLC cadre.
 - c. Privately owned vehicles of WLC cadre.
 - d. Leaving the Fort Carson cantonment, without permission.
