

Bio for CSM Berube

CSM Berube entered active duty in 1983, beginning his career in the military by attending both Basic and AIT as an Infantryman and Jump School at Ft Benning, Georgia. While on active duty his assignments included: driver of a Bradley Infantry Fighting Vehicle with the 1st Battalion 4th Infantry, Aschaffenberg, Germany; Training NCO, HHC 1st Brigade, Ft Carson, Colorado; Squad Leader, 4th MP Co, Ft Carson, Colorado; Squad Leader of a Military Police Detachment for a Physical Security SCIF, 307th Military Intelligence Battalion, Ludwigsburg Germany; Desk Sergeant and Traffic Accident Investigator, 6th Area Support Group, Stuttgart, Germany. While on Active Duty CSM Berube participated in three REFORGER Exercises, one NTC Rotation and one Border Augmentation Mission in the Federal Republic of Germany and attended MP School at Ft. McClellan, Alabama.

In 1992 CSM Berube entered the Colorado National Guard, where he was assigned to the 220th MP Co. While assigned to the 220th MP Company, CSM Berube held the positions of Team Leader, Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, Operations Sergeant and First Sergeant. CSM Berube's state activation's include: Blizzard of 97, Buffalo Creek, Bobcat, Coal Seam, and Hayman Fires, and the Colorado National Guard response to the Columbine High School tragedy. CSM Berube deployed in support of Operation Joint Forge to Hungary and the Balkans as a Platoon Sergeant in 1999 & Operation Iraqi Freedom during the initial invasion of Iraq in 2003 as First Sergeant of the 220th MP Company.

After returning from Operation Iraqi Freedom, CSM Berube was assigned to the 891st Battalion as the Personnel NCOIC and graduated from the Sergeants Major Academy at Ft Bliss, Texas in 2006. In 2007, he was selected as the Command Sergeant Major of the 193rd MP BN and served in that capacity until December 2008 when he was selected as the Command Sergeant Major of the 89th Troop Command. In April of 2011, CSM Berube assumed his new duties as the State Command Sergeant Major for the Colorado Army National Guard.

CSM Berube's awards include Meritorious Unit Commendation, Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal 2nd Award, Army Commendation Medal, 4th Oak Leaf Cluster, Army Achievement Medal 5th Oak Leaf Cluster, Good Conduct Medal 2nd Award, Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal, 3rd Oak Leaf Cluster, National Defense Service Medal 2nd Award, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal with Bronze Hourglass, and "M" device, 2nd Award, NCO Professional Development Ribbon with Numeral Four, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon 3rd Award, Army Reserve Components Overseas Training Ribbon with Numeral Two and NATO Medal, Parachutist Badge, and Expert Infantry Badge.

CSM Berube is currently assigned to the Joint Forces Headquarters as the State Command Sergeant Major. CSM Berube's full-time occupation is with the Denver Police Department.
