### SPECIALTY OUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must meet the Air Force physical fitness standards.
- 2. Must hold a Secret security clearance with eligibility for Top Secret.
- 3. Any AFSC is eligible to apply for this position; 3D, 1C6, 1N experience are desirable.
- 4. Must maintain worldwide deployable requirements.
- 5. Knowledge is mandatory including electronics theory, information technology, telecommunications and supervisory and control systems including cryptography, vulnerability assessment and exploitation techniques. Additionally knowledge will include operational planning, governing cyberspace operations directives, procedures and tactics.
- 6. Experience with missile warning, space electronic warfare, cybersecurity, or instructor duty desirable.
