




EDUCATION & YOUTH



Program Focus Areas





ECONOMIC MOBILITY & RURAL



Program Focus Areas



In November 2021, the Polis-Primavera Administration, AmeriCorps, Serve Colorado, and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) signed a Memorandum of Understanding to support the economic mobility of Coloradans. This successful partnership led to a two-year extension of the Economic Mobility MOU in November 2022. This commitment includes strategies to boost enrollment in tax credits, enhance financial literacy, provide tax filing assistance, and support affordable housing options. Working together, all streams of AmeriCorps service are looking for ways to prioritize the economic mobility of Coloradans.
