AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to current members of the Colorado Air National Guard in the grades of: E5 to E6 (Unless otherwise specified in "WHO MAY APPLY" above). Individual selected will receive an Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Tour with the Colorado Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief Memorandum For Record (MFR) will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the airman as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

2. *Air AGR Requirement* Current (within 30 days) 8-page Records Review RIP printout (Available on vMPF)
3. *Air AGR Requirement* Current and passing Report of Individual Fitness from myFitness (must be current as of close date on Announcement)
4. Copies of last two (2) EPRs/EPBs received
5. *Air AGR Requirement* Signed NGB 34-1, version 20131111

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must be a projected member of the Colorado Air National Guard and qualify for and be placed in the following compatible AFSC/AOC prior to receiving AGR orders: 2S07

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Any AFSC may Apply, this is a cross-training opportunity.
2. Applicant must be a COANG AGR

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

-Refer to Air Force Enlisted Classification Directory (AFECD) for specific duties related to the 2S0X1AFSC.
-Must be willing to cross-train into the Material Management 2S0X1 career field.
-Position is located at Airburst Range, Ft Carson CO. BAH will be calculated using the Fort Carson 80913 zip-code.
-Airburst Range has multiple AFSC's and integration into all facets is necessary for mission accomplishment.
-Will be required to learn and perform Airburst Range Operating Procedures (AFMAN 13-212), checklists and Operating Instructions.
-Will be required to work non-standard duty days to include nights and weekends necessary to support Airburst Range mission requirements.
-Must not be afraid of heights. Duties will include Tower Safety which involves monitoring ground maneuvers/personnel during flight operations.
-Additional range operations duties to include: Threat Simulator Operations, Remote Target Vehicle Operations/Troubleshooting, Weapons Impact Scoring Set Operator, and Wildland Firefighting.
