Individual selected will receive an Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Tour with the Colorado Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be experienced in all Airburst Range operating procedures, checklists and Operating Instructions
- 2. Must be very familiar and experienced with the missions and common users of Airburst Range, both air and ground
- 3. Must coordinate with 140th Wing, 120th FS, Fort Carson Range Control, Butts AAF, 13th ASOS, EOD and other users.
- 4. Must not be afraid of heights

- Directly responsible for the proper support and maintenance of Airburst Range
- Supervise activities and personnel assigned to the range at all times
- Ensure all range personnel are briefed on safety, operations and fire procedures
- Ensure all personnel are trained in all aspects of daily operations and equipment based on mission requirements
- Ensure training and readiness of all assigned range personnel
- Monitor range activities to ensure compliance with published directives and safety criteria
