In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief Memorandum For Record (MFR) will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the airman as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

5. 1-page letter as to why you want to be the Student Flight NCOIC with SEL and Squadron CC concurrence. Concurrence can be on a 2nd page.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Motivated to welcome and take great care of our newest enlisted members. Communicate RSD schedules and coordinate attendance with all trainees. Ensure enlistees in-process and complete financial package for pay & benefits. Assisting with base access to ensure trainees are able to report to RSD. Coordinate RSD lodging for required trainees. MILPDS access to assist with formal school requests as needed. Alternate Security Manager duties responsible for processing security clearance of all Student Flt trainees

Creation of Student Flight Drill Weekend Training Plan which includes:

- Teaching material that will prepare for Basic Training
- Coordinate monthly Physical Fitness during each RSD
- Coordinate Guest Speakers for each RSD to teach benefits, resources, and other pertinent material
- Coordinating and communicating with all squadrons across the Wing on attendance, shop training plan, etc.
- Collaborate with education/training and recruiting offices for different requirements

Program Manning Resource:

This is a full-time position that requires a 2-year commitment from the selected candidate. (2-year Wing funded AGR order)

*If a DSG or DST is selected, he/she will be placed on OTOT orders for the duration of the assignment.

*If an AGR is selected, the losing unit will receive an OTOT authorization to backfill the selected candidate for the duration of the assignment.

*Assigned squadron must have force management plan for member's return at completion of the career broadening assignment.
