Must be a current member of the CO Air National Guard within the grade(s) of E3 and E6.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to current members of the Colorado Air National Guard in the grades of: E3 to E6 (Unless otherwise specified in "WHO MAY APPLY" above). Individual selected will receive an Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Tour with the Colorado Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed WILL be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief Memorandum For Record (MFR) will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the airman as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must be a projected member of the Colorado Air National Guard and qualify for and be placed in the following compatible AFSC/AOC prior to receving AGR orders: 3E2X

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must hold 3E2X1 AFSC to Apply for Position

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

- 1. Refer to Air Force Enlisted Classification Directory (AFECD) for specific duties related to the 3E271 AFSC.
- 2. Position is located at Airburst Range, Ft Carson CO. BAH will be calculated using the Fort Carson 80913 zip-code.
- 3. Member responsible for range maintenance to include maintaining firebreaks, maintaining interior and perimeter dirt roads, target construction and design.
- 4. Airburst Range has multiple AFSC's and integration into all facets is necessary for mission accomplishment.
- 5. Range knowledge is desirable, but all will be required to learn and perform Airburst Range Operating Procedures (AFMAN 13-212), checklists and Operating Instructions.
- 6. Will be required to work non-standard duty days to include nights and weekends necessary to support Airburst Range mission requirements.
- 7. Must not be afraid of heights. Duties will include Tower Safety, monitoring ground maneuvers/personnel during flight operations.
- 8. Will be required to pass S-130/S-190 Basic Wildland Firefighting Courses.
