Must be a current member of the COANG within the ranks of E7-E8 and hold the 2A or 2W AFSC.

**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** This position is open to current members of the Colorado Air National Guard in the grades of: E7 to E8 (Unless otherwise specified in "WHO MAY APPLY" above). Individual selected will receive an Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Tour with the Colorado Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING:** The documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief Memorandum For Record (MFR) will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the airman as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

**POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

**The individual(s) must be a projected member of the Colorado Air National Guard and qualify for and be placed in the following compatible AFSC/AOC prior to receiving AGR orders: 2A39**

**MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must be a COANG member
2. Must possess the 2A or 2W AFSC
3. Must have CCAF or equivalent degree which must reflect on RIP, or provide a copy of transcript and CCAF degree progress report
4. Must be promotion eligible to SMSgt by 31 Dec 2026

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:**

- Direct and sustain 24/7/365 Alert operations in support of Operation NOBLE EAGLE, serving as the Enlisted authority for executing a no-fail, round-the-clock aerospace control alert mission.
- Serve as the primary enlisted advisor on all matters related to aircraft maintenance and mission generation, leading a mission-focused effort and managing all resources necessary to accomplish the mission safely and effectively.
- Advise the Alert OIC and other senior leaders on scheduled and unscheduled maintenance, especially actions that may impact aircraft required for the Alert Special Instructions (SPINS).
- Provide robust management and oversight to ensure the Alert section is adequately resourced and supervised across all shifts, balancing manning and workload to execute the maintenance plan effectively.
- Serve as a key liaison between Alert and the parent unit, including other base agencies, Operations Group, and Wing leadership on all maintenance and mission-related issues.
- Guarantee continuous mission readiness for all high-visibility First Air Force (1AF) Alert Force Operational Assessments (AFOA) and Air Combat Command (ACC) Alert Force Evaluations (AFE), ensuring the unit achieves and sustains highest-tier ratings.
- Enforce absolute compliance with all Communications Security (COMSEC), physical security, and program protection requirements across all alert facilities and mission-critical communications networks.
- Enforce rigorous occupational safety standards and mishap prevention programs across all Alert facilities and flightline operations, proactively identifying hazards to guarantee a zero-accident, combat-ready environment.
- Develop and manage a comprehensive work center training program. Evaluate personnel qualifications, track training requirements, and ensure all training documentation is precise and up-to-date.
- Review and evaluate the quality of maintenance on both aircraft and equipment. Analyze inspection results and trends to identify and correct root causes of deficiencies.
- Ensure all weapons training and load crew requirements are met, including the certification and training of load crew members to home station standards.
- Maintain and exercise Exceptional Release (ER) authority, making final airworthiness determinations for mission aircraft under time-sensitive and critical conditions.

- Ensure strict compliance with all technical orders, directives, and written guidance. Review and validate maintenance procedures to ensure tasks are completed in a compliant, safe, and timely manner.
  - Develop, coordinate, and maintain functional and emergency action checklists for events such as aircraft damage, severe weather, and hazardous material incidents to ensure rapid and effective response.
  - Attend and provide critical input to daily, weekly, and monthly maintenance and flying schedule meetings, developing and executing plans to meet all operational and training requirements.
  - Ensure the accurate and timely reporting of aircraft status, including discrepancies, estimated time of completion, and configuration, to the Maintenance Operations Center (MOC), Command Post, and Western Air Defense Sector (WADS).
  - Ensure all aircraft on Alert status meet the specific requirements of the relevant special instructions (SPINS).
  - Maintain impeccable professional standards with no active Unfavorable Information Files (UIF), control rosters, or open Inspector General (IG) investigations, demonstrating the highest level of personal and professional integrity required for a high-profile leadership position.
  - Possess and maintain an active Secret security clearance (minimum) as a mandatory condition of employment, ensuring access to required networks, restricted alert facilities, and classified mission briefings.
