DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a. Gain and maintain Combat Mission Ready (CMR) status as a Space Control Operator and Space Control Crew Commander.
- b. Demonstrate technical expertise, weapon system knowledge, operational excellence and strong leadership.
- c. Attend an Instructor Qualification Course (IQC), either locally developed or administered by an outside agency, covering instructional methods, tips and techniques, and platform presence.
- d. Develop effective instruction techniques and provide instruction to pipeline students or re-trainees on operational weapon system
- e. Be familiar with Instructional Systems Design process and procedures, construction and administration of knowledge tests, construction and administration of training scenarios (individual tasks or multiple tasks), construction and administration of lesson plans.
- f. Maintain qualification as an instructor every 18 months.
- g. Prepare to execute space control operations and deploys in support of Combatant Commander's priorities.
- h. Performs deployment commander responsibilities. This includes the oversight of pre-deployment planning, site surveying, equipment preparation, personnel readiness and preparation relative to mission operations. Prepares and conducts briefings and debriefings for deploying personnel and senior staff. Plans and oversees resources dedicated to deployment activity. Recommends, writes and updates policies and procedures and guidance to support deployed operations. Oversees mission operations at deployed locations.
- i. Reviews, analyzes, and resolves difficult and highly complex telecommunications problems.
- j. Develops and participates in space operations exercises which test the capabilities and proficiency of the crew.
- k. Performs one or more specialized duties. These duties may include crew evaluator, instructor, or mission software testing.
- l. Perform additional duties as assigned.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

- a. Knowledge. The following common knowledge is mandatory for this position: Knowledge: Possesses knowledge of a wide range of communications concepts, principles, and practices; and an in-depth knowledge of specific functional areas of satellite communications to accomplish work processes through the use of telecommunication devices, methods, services, and facilities.
- b. Position requires a Top Secret/SCI clearance
- c. If selected does not hold AFSC of 13S3D, individual will be required to retrain
- Training includes attendance in an undergraduate space training course at Vandenberg AFB, CA
- d. Selected must complete Mission Qualification Training in unit's weapon system
- e. Must maintain world wide deployable requirements
