

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES				

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

This is a commissioning opportunity for those eligible.

DUTIES: This position is located at Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado Springs, CO. Its purpose is to provide superior leadership guidance and support to the 138 Space Control Squadron's Mission Assurance Flight.

- a. Gain and maintain Combat Mission Ready (CMR) status as a Space Control Operator and Space Control Crew Commander.
- b. Prepare to execute space control operations and deploys in support of Combatant Commander's priorities.
- c. Oversees development of briefings and mission preparation, including combat planning, weather factors, mission objectives, and other agency coordination to ensure effective mission execution.
- e. Makes mission and personnel recommendations to operations officer and squadron commander.
- f. Develops and participates in space operations exercises which test the capabilities and proficiency of the crew.
- g. Performs one or more specialized duties. These duties may include crew evaluator, instructor, or mission software testing.
- h. Perform additional duties as assigned.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must meet the Air Force physical fitness standards.
- 2. Must be able to obtain a Top Secret Security Clearance.
- 3. Selectee must meet a minimum of Tier 3 entry education requirements as outlined in the Air Force Officer Classification Directory (AFOCD) dated 30 April 2019; 13S candidates for this announcement must possess a Bachelor or Master of Science Degree prior to commissioning.
- 4. Must maintain worldwide deployable requirements.
- 5. Nationwide applicants must have STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) degree. Top Secret security clearance is desirable.
