1. Leads team of cyber, satellite communications, logistics and other support personnel
2. Provides oversight for current and future mission systems and communication infrastructure, ensuring product quality, statutory and regulatory compliance
3. Oversees deployment and exercise preparation of Mission Assurance teams, logistics, equipment and supplies
4. Makes mission and personnel recommendations to squadron commander
6. Perform additional duties as assigned

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must meet the Air Force physical fitness standards.
2. Must hold a Secret Clearance and capable of upgrading to a Top Secret security clearance.
3. Selectee must meet Tier 1 or Tier 2 entry education requirements as outlined in the Air Force Officer Classification Directory (AFOCD) dated 30 April 2019; 17X candidates must possess a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) degree prior to commissioning.
4. Must maintain worldwide deployable requirements.
