Minimum AFOQT scores are in accordance with AFI 36-2005 (dated 19 May 2003) and ANGI 36-2005 (15 March 2005, Certified Current 22 August 2013):

a. Verbal 15, Quantitative 10, Pilot 25, Navigator 10, and Pilot + Navigator at least 50. Minimum Grade Point Averages are 2.3 (90-104/135-156 semester/quarter hours), 2.2 (105-119/157-179 hours), or 2.1 (120+/180+ hours)
