DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

DUTIES: This position is located at Greeley Air National Guard Station, Greeley CO. Its purpose is to provide superior leadership, guidance and support to the 233d Space Group (233SG) and 137th Space Warning Squadron (137 SWS) and serve as a as a Mobile Ground System (MGS) subject matter expert.

- a. Executes the unit’s missile warning mission. Detects, analyzes, and reports missile launches, space launches and nuclear detonations to the National Command Authority (NCA). Configures multiple complex voice, text and data communications systems. Identifies, analyzes, and reports system anomalies to maintenance, test & analysis and command agencies. Performs Communications Security and Operations Security related duties. Maintains proficiency and knowledge as a space and missile warning operator.
- b. Performs Field Commander responsibilities. This includes the oversight of pre-deployment planning, site surveying, equipment preparation, personnel readiness and preparation relative to mission operations. Prepares and conducts briefings and debriefings for deploying personnel and senior staff. Plans and oversees resources dedicated to deployment activity. Recommends, writes and updates policies and procedures and guidance to support deployed operations. Oversees mission operations at deployed locations.
- c. Performs one or more specialized duties. These duties may include crew evaluator, instructor, or mission software testing.
- d. Serves as the Main Operating Base Officer in Charge. Oversees operations and maintenance personnel to support higher headquarters mission requirements. Coordinates all on-station daily activities on behalf of the unit commander. Helps manage crisis situations by providing the commander and other unit senior staff with timely critical information and report dissemination to appropriate agencies.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

- a. Completion of a current Single Scope Background Investigation (SSBI) according to AFI 31-501, Personnel Security
- b. For entry into this specialty, normal color vision as defined in AFI 48-123, Medical Examinations and Standards.
- c. Attendance in a undergraduate space training course at Vandenberg AFB. CA. Due to the length of OUST attendance will be a PCS. Attendance in a Mission Qualification Training Course at the 137th Space Warning Squadron.
- d. Undergraduate Degree requirements IAW Air Force Officer Classification Directory (AFOCD) 31
