DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

Member must be able to fulfill the AFSC requirements of the 4FPAN UTC MISCAP

Provides Senior Enlisted leadership in operations and engineering management to unified command, war-fighting headquarters, or combined task force augmentation for engineer command and control in support of regional contingencies.

Provides oversight and management for base operating support and engineer command and control requirements to include support for Rapid Airfield Damage Recovery capability.

Performs planning activities and conducts facility surveys. Surveys proposed work to determine resource requirements. Obtains certifications, special tools, and equipment for assigned personnel. Ensures compliance with all safety and environmental regulations.

Coordinates, monitors, and executes contingency and Prime BEEF training requirements and associated deployment preparation programs and duties. Ensures personnel are in a constant ready state to meet deployment commitments.

Coordinates, monitors, and executes contract quality assurance functions as required.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge is mandatory of CE policies, operations practices, and procedures for constructing, maintaining, and operating real estate, facilities, systems, and equipment; supply procedures, directives, and policies; information management systems use; and work force management requirements, interpretation, and application of technical guidance, directives, operational plans, and command policies.

Must currently hold one of the following PAFSC; 3E071, 3E072, 3E171, 3E271, 3E371, 3E471, 3E571, 3E671 to meet the 4FPAN UTN MISCAP requirements. A MCR will be completed once a candidate is selected to change the positions DAFSC to match the qualified member.

Must be eligible to meet Colorado State Promotion Board for E8 within 3 months of selection.
