DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary purpose of this position is to install, modify, overhaul, maintain, troubleshoot, repair, align, calibrate, and rebuild multi-system avionics complexes consisting of multiple completely integrated electronic avionics systems where the complex accomplishes a number of major functions. Performs scheduled and unscheduled maintenance on one or more multi-complex electronic integrated systems. Reviews and analyzes maintenance data; determines if criteria are sufficient to provide adequate test, troubleshooting and repair procedures; devises and recommends tests, procedural changes, or data corrections. Troubleshoots operational malfunctions and analyzes system performance utilizing aircrew debrief data, Technical Orders, schematic and wiring diagrams, engineering drawings, data analysis, common and system-specific test equipment and built in system tests. Recommends methods to improve equipment performance, technical data, and maintenance procedures by reporting hardware and software malfunctions, initiates material deficiency reports both on equipment and in technical data, and assists in design changes as necessary.

In addition:

1. Trains/mentors Airmen involved in the maintenance, repair, and modification of integrated multi-complex avionics systems. Establishes deadlines and priorities and work assignments based on work schedules, methods, and policies set by Production and MXG Leadership. Coordinates work with supporting or related work functions controlled by other sections. Redirects individual workers and resources to accomplish unanticipated work. Informs higher level supervisors of the need to revise work schedules and other resources.
2. Determines training needs of subordinates and arranges for its accomplishment. Mentors and counsels Airmen on how to improve their performance and explains new work techniques. Initiates recommendations for promotion or reassignment of subordinates.
3. Implements safety regulatory requirements. Ensures subordinates wear appropriate safety equipment and follow pertinent technical and safety regulations. Implements and directs standard housekeeping practices.
4. Prepares for and participates in various types of readiness evaluations, inspections, mobilization and command support exercises.
5. Performs other duties as assigned.
