DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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See DAFECD for duties associated with the AFSC.

This position is located at Greeley Air National Guard Station, Greeley, CO. Its purpose is to provide superior leadership and guidance to the enlisted force and support the 233d Space Group (233 SG) subordinate units with expert knowledge on all aspects of the Mobile Ground System (MGS) and future mission sets.

Specific Duties: Manage, install, integrate, and configure SATCOM terminal for operational and test networks. Prioritize scheduled and unscheduled maintenance and inspections on the specialized terminal. Maintain and utilize specialized test equipment. Attend meetings representing the flight's interests when delegated. Provide real-time updates readiness statuses.

- a. Maintain high state of readiness at all times.
- b. Assist Flight Chief with administrative functions and assigned programs.
- c. Serve as a senior enlisted leader in various positions employing and operating mission processing vehicles.
- d. Monitor enlisted force development to include: PME requirements, promotion eligibility, AFSC training and formal schools; submit promotion recommendations through chain of command.
- e. Promote health and welfare of personnel and report on issues affecting morale, quality of life, workloads and duty performance.
- f. Provide support and supervision of multiple assigned Total Force personnel.
- g. Produce accurate Enlisted Performance Briefs and Airman Comprehensive Assessments for assigned personnel.
- h. Oversee task and training activities for all subordinates.
- i. Provide technical advice, career counseling, and mentorship to subordinate personnel.
- j. Lead small teams to perform all aspects of maintenance and operations of mission processing vehicles.
- k. Perform additional duties as assigned.
- l. Failure to meet above expectations will be cause for removal and/or demotion.
- m. Short Notice Title 10 Orders for Federal Operational Missions: As a condition of employment, incumbent may be required to be recalled to Title 10 duty federal operational missions with little notice.
- n. Willingness and availability to attend special training on short notice.
