DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a. Gain and maintain Combat Mission Ready (CMR) status as a Space Control Operator and Space Control Crew Chief.
- b. Prepare to execute space control operations and deploys in support of Combatant Commander's priorities.
- c. Reviews, analyzes, and resolves difficult and highly complex telecommunications problems.
- d. Oversees development of briefings and mission preparation, including combat planning, weather factors, mission objectives, and other agency coordination to ensure effective mission execution.
- e. Makes mission and personnel recommendations to operations officer and squadron commander.
- f. Develops and participates in space operations exercises which test the capabilities and proficiency of the crew.
- g. Performs one or more specialized duties. These duties may include crew evaluator, instructor, or mission software testing.
- h. Perform additional duties as assigned.

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be qualified to retrain into 1C6X1 within two years of hire

1. Knowledge. The following common knowledge is mandatory for this position: Possesses knowledge of a wide range of communications concepts, principles, and practices; and an in-depth knowledge of specific functional areas of satellite communications to accomplish work processes through the use of telecommunication devices, methods, services, and facilities.
2. Must be a Master Sergeant or promotable Technical Sergeant.
3. Must meet the Air Force physical fitness standards.
4. Must hold a Top Secret security clearance.
5. If selectee does not hold AFSC of 1C6X1, individual will be required to retrain.
 - a. Training includes attendance in an undergraduate space training course at Vandenberg AFB, CA.
6. Selectee must complete Mission Qualification Training in unit's weapon system.
7. Must maintain worldwide deployable requirements.
