DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

Installs, operates, maintains, and repairs heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration (HVAC/R) systems, combustion equipment, and industrial air compressors. Interprets drawings and schematics, and installs HVAC/R components.

Installs, repairs, fabricates, and tests piping and tubing systems. Installs, connects, troubleshoots, and maintains HVAC/R controls. Tests HVAC/R equipment for proper operation. Balances air and water in HVAC systems. Monitors systems operation to ensure efficiency and compliance technical orders, manufacturer handbooks, local procedures, codes, and directives. Evaluates water treatment for heating and cooling systems. Ensures compliance with safety and environmental regulations for fuels, refrigerants, and hazardous materials. Manages HVAC/R fuel emissions and refrigerant handling programs and activities.

Performing or supervising functions of HVAC/R systems, new facility design review and approval, psychrometric procedures, calculating heat load requirements, measuring subcooling and superheat, and electrical troubleshooting.

Performs planning activities. Performs facility surveys. Surveys proposed work to determine resource requirements. Prepares cost estimates for in-service work. Applies engineered performance standards to plan and estimate jobs. Coordinates plans and other activities.

Related DoD Occupational Subgroup: 172000.

Supervises personnel, conducts training, and creates duty schedules. Coordinates, monitors, and executes contingency and Prime BEEF training requirements and associated deployment preparation programs and duties. Ensures personnel are in a constant ready state to meet deployment commitments.

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:
