DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

This is a position on the Wing Air Staff as part of the A4 Directorate- Civil Engineering, Logistics & Maintenance. Duties at home station will be primarily focused on training for role in the deployed environment.

Primary Duties:

- Provide oversight, integration, and operational-level planning for and management of logistics capabilities for assigned and deploying units to the wing commander.
- Provide oversight and management of Time Phased Force Deployment Data (TPFDD) execution.
- Manage and coordinate Support Agreements.
- Manage assigned War Reserve Materiel (WRM), identify new requirements, and communicate shortfalls.
- Coordinate Contingency Plans for wing command and control and identify wing risk and degradations.
- Liaise with A3 for current operations and A5 for strategic posture and future operations.
- Collect, analyze, and provide key decision information for transportation, to include airlift missions (ex. SAAM, Channel), in-transit visibility, inbound/outbound cargo and passengers, ground transportation capability, vehicle fleet health, critical and mission essential vehicles.
- Ensure access to transportation systems (ex. SMS, GATES, GTN), information and load planning capability.

Experience: Joint Operational Planning and Execution System (JOPES), Deliberate and Crisis Action Planning and Execution Segments (DCAPES), Logistics Module (LOGMOD)
