DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

If selected for this position, applicant must complete all required training to attain Air Force Specialty Code of 11F3H (Aircraft Commander, F-16). This includes, but is not limited to:

Total Force Officer Training (TFOT)

Air Force Initial Flight Training (IFT) [waived if individual possess Private Pilot's License]

Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT)

Introduction to Fighter Fundamentals (IFF)

Survival, Evasion, Resistance, & Escape (SERE)

Water Survival

Centrifuge Training

Physiological Training / Altitude Chamber

F-16 Basic Course (B-Course)

F-16 Mission Qualification Training (MQT)

Applicant must relocate to live in the Denver, Colorado metropolitan area upon completion of the F-16 Basic Course (B-Course).

Required training can require 2-3 years to complete after which applicant will be subsequently serve 3 consecutive years of Mission Essential Skills Training (MEST) as an F-16 pilot in the 120th Fighter Squadron, Colorado Air National Guard. During this period of service, applicant may deployed overseas in support of Global Force Management combat taskings. Applicant will be required to support the 140th Wing's alert force mission in support of US Northern Command which entails 2-5 monthly 24-hour alert shifts at Buckley Space Force Base, Colorado.

Upon completion of 3-year MEST period of service, applicant will retain a position as a Drill Status Guardsman (DSG) in the Colorado ANG and must apply for/compete for future full-time Active Guard Reserve (AGR) positions within the 140th Wing.
