DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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Refer to Air Force Enlisted Classification Directory (AFECD) for specific duties associated with this AFSC.

This position is located at Greeley Air National Guard Station, Greeley, CO. Its purpose is to provide superior leadership and guidance to the enlisted force and support the 233d Space Group (233 SG) and 233 SCS/SMFSW Flight Chief and Section Chief with expert knowledge on wireless radio and satellite systems and equipment maintenance activities.

- Maintain high state of readiness at all times.
- Assist Flight Chief with administrative functions and shop programs.
- Performs/supervises wireless radio and satellite systems and equipment maintenance activities
- Monitor enlisted development to include PME needs and promotion eligibility as well as AFSC specific development and formal schools; submit promotion recommendations to the Flight Chief.
- Promote health and welfare of personnel and report to the SMFSW Flight Chief on issues affecting morale, quality of life, workloads and duty performance.
- Perform duties as Element Chief of Section functional areas.
- Provide support and supervision of DSG, AGR and Technician enlisted Air National Guard personnel.
- Produce Enlisted Performance Briefs and Airman Comprehensive Assessments for assigned personnel.
- Plan and schedule task and training activities for all Element members.
- Provide technical advice, career counseling, performance feedback and overall guidance to subordinate personnel.
- Deploys and activates mobile and transportable transmission equipment.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.
- Failure to meet above expectations will be cause for removal and/or demotion.
- Short Notice Title 10 Orders for Federal Operational Missions: As a condition of employment, incumbent may be required to be recalled to Title 10 duty pursuant to 10 U.S. C.B. 12301 (d) for federal operational missions.
- Willingness and availability to attend special training on short notice.
- Maintain COMP-TIA certification when awarded, must keep current on all requirements.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Applicants must hold or be eligible to obtain TOP SECRET (SCI Eligible) security clearance.
2. Applicants must meet Information Assurance Technical (IAT) Level II requirements.
3. Must maintain worldwide deployment eligibility requirements.
4. Short Notice Title 10 Orders for Federal Operational Missions: As a condition of employment, incumbent may be required to be recalled to Title 10 active duty pursuant to 10 U.S.C. §12301(d) for federal operational missions.
5. Irregular Schedule and TDYs: Selectee will be required to work shifts, holidays, weekends and regularly perform extended duty periods away from home station and temporary duty (TDY) both in-state and out-of-state.
6. Must currently hold 1D772R AFSC, SEI code 1AR, or have RF Transmission experience (3D1X3 or 1D7X1R).
7. Applicant should have familiarity with resource management and/or financial management for military entity and be familiar with DTS and GTC and other budgetary reconciliation procedures.
8. Must obtain commercial driver's license equivalent training and able to safety transport assets over the road.
