Primary Duties:

1. Selectee will be responsible for leading two elements of Cyber Operations Airmen and their subordinates.
2. Supervise the professional and personal development, health, morale and welfare of assigned Airmen and subordinates.
3. Lead the design, building, provisioning, maintaining, and sustainment of information systems, including warfighter communications. This role is responsible for deploying, sustaining, troubleshooting, and repairing standard voice, data, and video network infrastructure systems, IP detection systems, and cryptographic equipment.
4. Lead small teams to fabricate, terminate, and interconnect wiring and associated network infrastructure devices.
5. Responsible for leading and managing Tier 1/2 client system operations efforts.
6. Provide training to the work center in topics including but not limited to industry best practices, cyber hygiene, and other system administration/network operations tasks.
7. Respond to and report service outages and interruptions to network operations.
8. Complete additional duties as assigned.
