**DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:**

A. Title: INTELLIGENCE OFFICER, TRADITIONAL

B. Auth AFSC: 14N

C. Auth Status: Limited to individuals capable of gaining commission and obtaining the 14N AFSC.

4. DUTIES: Performs intelligence operations and applications activities in support of an F16 squadron. Performs production, processing, and dissemination of products. Develops and distributes targeting maps, charts, and geodesy (MC&G) products. Performs analysis and fusion of collected intelligence, and produces assessments to meet operational requirements during peace time and combat operations. Analyzes data to advise planners and squadron pilots of options to accomplish objectives. Evaluates mission accomplishment to determine adversary capability and requirements for retargeting. Assists in operational employment planning. Advises commanders and pilots on threat systems deployment, employment, tactics, capabilities, and vulnerabilities. Provides regular briefings to the wing commander, subordinate commanders, pilots and personnel, on worldwide political/military and tactical intelligence. Provides intelligence support and assists in planning and execution of training and combat sorties. Exchanges and collects intelligence with other services, agencies, and governments. Conducts operations, related activities and other duties as assigned.

5. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS: Must fully comply with AFI 36-2903 Dress and Personal Appearance and Weight Program standards. Must be eligible to obtain and maintain a Top Secret security clearance and be eligible for access to SCI. Ability to attend Intelligence Officer Training and F-16 Intelligence Formal Training Course (IFTU).
