DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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1. Principal advisor to the Commander, 233d Space Communications Squadron.
2. This position is for the Senior Enlisted Leader of the 233 Space Communications Squadron (SCS) and is a critical leadership role within the 223d Space Group and the 140th Wing.
3. Responsible to the 233d Communications Squadron Commander for overall leadership and management of all enlisted personnel assigned to the Squadron.
4. Provide leadership, management, and guidance in organizing, equipping, and training 233SCS members to meet mission requirements.
5. Directs activities responsible for system analysis and design, programming, operations and maintenance, security, systems management, technical support, plans, implementation, and resource management.
6. Implements and interprets policies, directives, and procedures. Must be an active visible leader.
7. Promote and enable deliberate development of junior enlisted Airmen, NCOs, and fellow SNCOs into better followers, leaders, and supervisors.
8. General knowledge of ANG/USAF manpower, personnel, finance, and medical instructions/processes is required.
9. This position represents the 233SCS for personnel issues within the Career Field, with Functional Area Managers, State Human Resources Office, and higher headquarters.
10. Familiar with Logistics, communications-electronics, security forces, and supply instructions/practices is also desirable.
11. Oversees enlisted selection boards, serves on awards/decoration boards, and quarterly/annual boards as needed.
12. Applicant must maintain positive relationships with the members of the Colorado Air National Guard and all supporting agencies.
13. Applicant should have extensive experience managing personnel, processes, and programs in support of the Wing's mission.
14. Applicant should have an intimate knowledge of all AFSCs and shreds in the Communications Squadron.
15. Applicant must have previously worked in a career field supporting space operations and have extensive experience within the NC3 portfolio.
16. Desirable but not necessary: Bachelor degree in any field of study, Master's degree in any field of study.
