DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

The 138th Electromagnetic Warfare Squadron is seeking a highly motivated, technically proficient Materiel Management Craftsman (2S071) to serve as a Drill Status Guardsman (DSG). The successful candidate will oversee logistics, supply, and warehouse operations, ensuring the unit's combat readiness and domestic response capabilities. As a 7-level Craftsman, you will provide critical technical expertise, manage asset inventories, and mentor junior Airmen during Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs) and Annual Training (AT) periods.

Supervision & Mentorship:

- Lead, train, and certify junior 3- and 5-level Airmen on core supply tasks.
- Oversee upgrade training (UGT) progression and conduct career development reviews.
- Supervise section shifts and assign daily tasks during UTAs.

Inventory & Asset Management:

- Conduct physical inventories, investigate discrepancies, and reconcile balances.
- Administer stock control operations, compute requirements, and process transactions using ILS-S.
- Manage specialized storage programs, including classified, sensitive, and hazardous materials.

Mobility & Logistics Support

- Maintain Mobility Readiness Spares Packages (MRSP) and combat readiness kits.
- Coordinate equipment transfers, process receipts, and manage unit equipment accounts.
- Ensure rapid mobilization readiness for domestic operations and federal deployments.

Compliance & Quality Control

- Enforce strict compliance with Air Force Joint Instructions, AFI 23-101, and local supply policies.
- Perform shelf-life inspections and manage the care of supplies in storage (COSIS) program.
- Identify and resolve systemic supply chain bottlenecks.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES (Cont'd):

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

- AFSC Requirement: Must currently hold the 2S071 AFSC or be a fully qualified 2S051 eligible for immediate entry into 7-level upgrade training).
- Grade: Fully qualified SSGT (E-5) or TSgt (E-6).
- Security Clearance: Must possess a Top Secret clearance with SCI eligibility
- Fitness Standard: Must meet and maintain current Air Force physical fitness standards.
- Participation: Must be able to attend all scheduled Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs) and Annual Training (AT) dates annually.
