DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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The selected candidate will serve as the principal enlisted leader, advisor, and director within their assigned functional flight. This position demands an experienced leader capable of translating commander's intent into operational execution, cultivating a culture of readiness, enforcing military standards, and deliberately mentoring junior NCOs and Airmen.

The candidate must possess extensive, proven experience in directing, planning, and executing the full spectrum of Force Support combat sustainment and community services. The candidate is expected to operate not merely as a technician, but as a SNCO responsible for flight-level leadership, resource stewardship, and personnel development.

Final placement into one of the following key leadership portfolios will be based on the selectee's strategic qualifications, professional leadership breadth, and the immediate operational requirements of the unit: FSRT NCOIC, UTM/UDM, Fitness NCOIC, Storeroom/Accounting or Kitchen Lead.
