DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES					
DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES: See DAFECD for duties associated with the AFSC.					
This position is located at Greeley Air National Guard Station, Greeley, CO. Its purpose is to support the 233d Space Group's mission sets through expert defensive cyber knowledge, skills and abilities. The selectee will assess, detect, and mitigate vulnerabilities to an array of specialized weapon systems. The selectee will have experience in project and/or program management for a squadron-sized entity having participated in or led conception, planning, and all other phases of project design and accomplishment.					
Specific Duties: a. Maintain high state of readiness at all times for self and assigned personnel.					
b. Assist the Flight Chief with administrative functions and assigned programs, including overseeing member travel, managing schedules, and coordinating training.					
c. Utilize knowledge of cyberspace terrain to incorporate protective measures, awareness, and training for early missile warning assets, personnel and architecture.					
d. Monitor enlisted force development to include: PME requirements, promotion eligibility, AFSC training and formal schools; submit promotion recommendations through chain of command.					
e. Promote health and welfare of personnel and report on issues affecting morale, quality of life, workloads and duty performance.					
f. Provide support and supervision of multiple assigned Total Force personnel.					
g. Produce timely and accurate Enlisted Performance Briefs and Airman Comprehensive Assessments for assigned personnel.					
h. Oversee task and training activities for all subordinates, including the planning and coordination of cyber exercises, conferences, and mobile training teams.					
i. Provide technical advice, coaching, career counseling, and mentorship to subordinate personnel.					
j. Lead small teams to conduct vulnerability assessments, provide recommendations for mitigation measures, and draft reports for military leaders.					
k. Perform additional duties as assigned.					
I. Failure to meet above expectations will be cause for removal and/or demotion.					
m. Short Notice for Domestic Operational Missions: As a condition of employment, incumbent may be recalled to support Domestic Operations with little notice.					

n. Willingness and availability to attend special training away from home station, including OCONUS.

Preferred Experience:

- Leadership position in military-related advocacy group such as junior enlisted council, rising six or similar organization.
- Most qualified applicants will have experience with integrated tactical warning/attack assessment operations experience and qualifications.

- Applicant must hold a minimum SECRET clearance.
- Applicant must hold or be able to obtain SEI 264, Information Assurance Technical Level 2 within one year of selection.
- Applicant will have advanced knowledge of cyber exercise types and objectives.
