3. Completion of PME commensurate with the grade and AFSC of the position, to include must complete E 7-Level Core Concepts distance learning course within 6 months, EJPME I within 12 months, EJPME II within 24 months.
4. Refer to Air Force Enlisted Classification Directory for specific duties associated with this AFSC.
5. Develops and executes Unit Training Assembly schedules in coordination with Prime BEEF Manager and Flight Commander. Manages all aspects of the Readiness and Upgrade Training and Education Program. Determines requirements for training and provide opportunities for internal and external training to support requirements. Ensures that one, three, and five year training plan is developed and maintained to include flight, squadron, and wing events. Trains, or directs training and certification on all tasks to 7-level requirements, documenting electronically.
