WHO MAY APPLY:

Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of CO within the grade(s) of E6 and E7.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **E6 to E7**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Certified Selection Board Copy of Soldier Record Brief (SRB) w/ ASVAB scores
3. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS and service members with DOR less than 5 years).
4. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
5. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
6. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
7. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
8. DA 705 with passing record ACFT score and HT/WT annotated dated within the last 6 months.
9. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT/WT standards
10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 68W

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be 68W MOS qualified or become 68W MOS qualified within 12 months of hire.
2. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
3. IAW AR 600-8-19 Current AGR Soldiers must have 18 Months in their current assignment if they were promoted to be eligible to apply for the lateral assignment.
4. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
5. PCS funds subject to availability.
6. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://fsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Serves as the Readiness NCO and advises the Commander and senior personnel on training, logistics, and personnel requirements. Directly responsible for the day-to-day operations of the unit and supervises the duty performance of two noncommissioned officers in personnel and logistics. As Detachment Sergeant, supervises the daily activities of 6 NCOs and 15 enlisted Soldiers, ensures all training and mission goals are accomplished; responsible to the Commander for ensuring successful accomplishment of the unit's training programs; drafts training schedules and maintains all training support materials; provides assistance and guidance in the preparation for and execution of unit training; conducts pre-execution visits at required training areas; maintains the unit MOS qualification training program; advises and assists the Commander on military education requirements for Soldiers in the unit.
