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AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of E6.

If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
  2. Certified Selection Board Copy of Soldier Record Brief (SRB) w/ ASVAB scores
  3. Photocopy of last 3 NCOERs (Must submit memos for gaps in NCOERs and Service Members with DOR less than 3 years).
  4. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
  5. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
  6. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
  7. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
  8. DA 705 with passing record ACFT score and HT/WT annotated dated within the last 6 months.
  9. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT/WT standards
  10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
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POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:  
The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 68W

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MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be 68W MOS qualified.
  2. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
  3. IAW AR 600-8-19 Current AGR Soldiers must have 18 Months in their current assignment if they were promoted to be eligible to apply for the lateral assignment.
  4. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
  5. PCS funds subject to availability.

Daily duties include being responsible for personnel actions, be the subject matter expert for all aeromedical, special school physicals. Be familiar with Department of the Army medical SOP and Regulations. Scheduling, conducting and tracking physical exams. Basic medical skills to include, but not limited to, the drawing of blood for laboratory testing, taking vital signs and height and weight. Conducting hearing testing, vision exams and electrocardiograms. Administer routine vaccinations. Process physical exams for electronic medical records input. Must maintain 68W MOS Qualifications.
