AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of E5.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.

- 1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
- 2. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
- 3. Photocopy of last 3 NCOERs (Must submit memos for gaps in NCOERs and Service Members with DOR less than 3 years).
- 4. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
- 5. Army Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
- 6. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
- 7. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
- 8. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
- 9. Individual Training Report (ITR) from DTMS showing passing ACFT and Height/Weight within the last six months

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 13M

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be 13M MOS qualified.
- 2. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
- 3. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
- 4. PCS funds subject to availability.
- 5. All application packets must be submitted online @ https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. Deployed applicants should send application emails to ng.co.coarng.list.agr@army.mil.
- 6. IAW AR 600-8-19 Current AGR Soldiers must have 18 Months in their current assignment if they were promoted to be eligible to apply for the lateral assignment.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Supervises specific human resources functions in a personnel office. Advise commanders on Soldiers and personnel readiness and strength levels of supported reporting units. Reviews consolidated reports, statistics, applications, and prepares recommendations for personnel actions to higher headquarters. Reviews and prepares reports and data on strength (gains and losses) of personnel and makes duty assignments of enlisted personnel. Review cyclic and other reports to assess systems performance. Maintain liaison with servicing data processing facility and field managers of interfaced systems.
