AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of E7.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position**. 1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).

- 2. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS).
- 3. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
- 4. Army Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
- 5. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
- 6. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
- 7. Individual Training Report (ITR) from DTMS showing passing ACFT and Height/Weight within the last six months
- 8. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
- 9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 42A

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be 42A MOS qualified.

- 2. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
- 3. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
- 4. PCS funds subject to availability.
