AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of O3.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
3. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
4. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
5. Security Clearance Verification Memo
6. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
7. Individual Training Report (ITR) from DTMS showing passing ACFT and Height/Weight within the last six months
8. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 35A

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Per the AGR Stabilization Policy dated 27 May 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotional opportunity.
2. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
3. Have the ability to obtain TS/SCI clearance within one year.
4. PCS funds subject to availability.

If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number.
