WHO MAY APPLY:

Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of CO within the grade(s) of O4 and O5. All applicants must have ILE complete and AOC complete or be AOC enrolled..

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of O4 to O5.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.

- 1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
- 2. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
- 3. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
- 4. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
- 5. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
- 6. Course completion certificates for ILE and AOC or ATTRS print out showing AOC registration.
- 7. Security Clearance Verification Memo
- 8. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
- 9. Individual Training Report (ITR) from DTMS showing passing ACFT and Height/Weight within the last six months
- 10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 01A

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must have "R" ASI
- 2. Applicant must have current Secret security clearance and be eligible to obtain a Top Secret within 12 months of hire.
- 3. Applicants must be willing to relocate within a 60 minute commute to Buckley AFB. PCS funds subject to availability.
- 4. Must be able to serve at least 3 years in the position prior to the Mandatory Removal Date (MRD).
- 5. This is a Category 1 AGR position. Category 1 positions are fenced and cannot be moved or transferred outside the unit assigned.
- 6. Special Note: Individual and collective team training investment mandates that assignment/selection to CST/WMD requires a minimum three-year tour.
- 7. Prior to placement a completed health physical IAW AR 40-501 Chap. 5 (Airborne) or CST OSHA Occupational Health Physical will be required if selected for the position. - 8. Per the COARNG AGR Stabilization Policy dated 27 May 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotion opportunity.
- 9. PCS funds subject to availability.
- 10. All application packets must be submitted online @ https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Initially will serve as second in command of a team of full-time (AGR) Army and Air Force National Guard personnel that respond to suspected terrorist attacks using Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD), and production or storage sites involving chemical, biological, and radiological substances as well as natural and manmade disasters. The team will assist first responders in the presumptive identification of hazardous materials, provide response and medical recommendations, and assist in coordination for follow on support. Coordinates with Joint Forces Headquarters-Colorado and National Guard Bureau Joint Operations Center. Provides continuous coordination with federal, state and local emergency medical, fire and law enforcement agencies. Responsible for \$10M in specialized mission equipment and will manage a \$500K budget using the US Army General Fund Enterprise Business System (GFEBS) software. Leads initiatives to increase training and readiness in specialized areas of expertise to external agencies across the spectrum of emergency responders. Serves as a spokesperson on numerous committees and organizations for emergency response. This position requires an above average amount of TDY due to the Op-tempo. All team members are required to respond to no-notice 90 minute recall to Buckley AFB at all times. Upon conclusion of current commander's tour, selectee will assume the duties of 8th Civil Support Team

(WMD) Commander.
