1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
3. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
4. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
5. Security Clearance Verification Memo
6. Copy of Soldier Talent Profile (STP) w/ ASVAB scores dated within 3 months.
7. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPPS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
8. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
10. Exception to Policy (ETP) memo for COARNG AGR Soldiers who are under 36 months in their current assignment. Does not apply for promotion opportunity announcements

**POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 153A

**MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Applicants who are 153A (Rotary Wing Aviator) qualified may apply
2. Must be AH-64E Instructor Pilot qualified
3. Must have 2000 hours of flight experience
4. Required to maintain flight status.
5. Prefer AH-64E MTP, if not qualified must be willing to attend MTP/AMOC
6. Prefer time teaching at an Aviation school (Rucker, WAATS, EAATS, etc.).
7. PCS funds subject to availability.
8. Must have current Secret Clearance

9. Per the COARNG AGR Stabilization Policy dated 7 September 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotion opportunity or an Exception to Policy Memo (ETP) is attached with application.

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Serves as an Instructor Pilot for Power Management and Mountain qualification. Teach ground school to aircrews in multiple airframes and DoD services. Assist the commander in developing and implementing the unit aircrew-training program (ATP) for the AH-64E Apache. Provide quality control for the AH-64E ATP via the commander's

standardization program. Along with their primary responsibilities, they mentor and professionally educate all unit crew members. The applicant will provide expertise on unit, crew, and collective training to the commander, and perform the following functions:

- Serves as member of the battalion standardization committee
- Advises commander on development of commander's task list (CTL).
- Monitors unit standardization and ATPs.
- Maintains unit individual aircrew training folders (IATFs).
- Monitors unit no notice programs
- Attend training meetings
- Administer the Total Army School System (TASS) accreditation process for HAATS
- Conduct Maintenance Test Flights as required in the AH-64E

Applicant must be an AH-64E IP. Prefer applicant be MTP qualified. Must have a minimum of 2000 hours of total flight time. 250 hours of Mountain Flight Experience

is preferred. Must have experience conducting classroom instruction and be able to speak in front of large groups. Preferred time teaching at an Aviation school (USAACE, WAATS, EAATS, FWAATS). Preferred graduate of the HAATS Mountain Qualification course. Prefer AWOAC complete at a minimum. Additionally, prefer a TASS accreditation specialist or experienced in TASS accreditation. Experience in teaching foreign students in the AH-64E preferred. Applicant should possess superior interpersonal skills. PCS funds may not be available.
