INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Security Clearance Verification Memo
3. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
4. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
5. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
6. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPPS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
7. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
8. Copy of all DD214's/NGB 22's showing all prior service.
9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:
The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 18A

- MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:
1. Must be 18A qualified.
 2. ILE completion preferred, but not required.
 3. Must be Jumpmaster qualified or must be able to attend the USASOC Jumpmaster course within 1 year of hire.
 4. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for 36 months and require a submitted ETP to apply, and an approved ETP to accept the position.
 5. Must have current Secret Clearance
 6. PCS funds subject to availability.
 7. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:
Responsible for the daily supervision and management of all full-time personnel assigned to the 5/19 SFG(A). Serves as the Battalion Commander's principal assistant for directing, coordinating, supervising, the 5/19 SFG(A) staff. Coordinates with 89th TC, 19th SFG(A), and TXARNG to meet 5/19 SFG(A) requirements. Ensures all critical administrative, logistical, and maintenance readiness metrics are achieved as the BN OIP coordinator and chief of staff. Tracks requirements for DTMS, CUSR, IPPS-A, and unit resource management. Tracks and completes all reporting requirements, tasking's, directives from higher headquarters Ensures staff planning occurs within the time frame provided by the Battalion commander. Performs other duties as assigned.
