If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
 2. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS).
 3. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
 4. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
 5. Army - Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
 6. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
 7. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPPS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
 8. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
 9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
 10. Exception to Policy (ETP) memo for AGR Soldiers who are under 36 months in their current assignment. Does not apply for promotion opportunity announcements

- MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:
1. Must be 42A MOS qualified.
 2. Must possess a current Secret clearance.

 5. Per the COARNG AGR Stabilization Policy dated 7 September 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotion opportunity or an Exception to Policy Memo (ETP) is attached with application.

Responsible for the day-to-day business of the AGR office. Supervises 1 - 2 NCOs. Oversees AGR board management including AGR announcements, application review, boarding, selection, in-processing, tour continuation boards, and active service management boards. Responsible for AGR strength accounting, duty position changes, separations, promotions, and retirements. Responsible for AGR PCS and AGR retirement PCS funds management. Processes AGR medical retirements. Oversees AGR DD214 production for separating and mobilizing AGRs. Supervises all IPPS-A, I-PERMS, and pay document review and processing. Serves as the J1 NCO during IDT periods and State Active Duty Mission support. Trains, educates, develops, designs and adapts the Joint Task Force Centennial (JTF-C) relevant to domestic operations in the state of Colorado.
