WHO MAY APPLY:

Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of CO within the grade(s) of E5 and E6.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **E5 to E6**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Photocopy of last 5 OERs/NCOERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs/NCOERs and Service Members with DOR less than 5 years).
3. Copy of Soldier Talent Profile (STP) w/ ASVAB scores dated within 3 months.
4. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
5. Security verification memo dated within the last 3 months
6. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPSS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
7. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
8. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
9. No longer than 1 pg MFR (IAW AR 25-50) will be submitted citing the documents missing
10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
11. Exception to Policy (ETP) memo for AGR Soldiers who are under 36 months in their current assignment. Does not apply for promotion opportunity announcements

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 17C

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must become 17C MOS qualified within 12 months of hire.
2. Applicant must have current Secret security clearance and be eligible to obtain a Top Secret / Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI) security clearance.
3. Qualifying ASVAB scores – A minimum score of 110 in General Technical (GT) and a minimum score of 112 in Skilled Technical (ST)
4. PCS funds subject to availability.
5. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. Deployed applicants should send application emails to ng.co.coarmg.list.agr@army.mil.
6. Per the COARNG AGR Stabilization Policy dated 7 September 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotion opportunity or an Exception to Policy Memo (ETP) is attached with application.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Develop, coordinate, and execute training plans, schedules, and calendars to ensure unit readiness. Manage training records and ensure compliance with Army training standards and regulations. Assist in the planning and execution of collective training events, including field exercises, weapons qualification ranges, and annual training. Coordinate logistical support for training activities. Maintain training documentation in systems such as ATIS and IPSS-A. Ensure accurate reporting of training completion and readiness metrics. Maintain accurate accountability of all unit property, equipment, and supplies using the Global Combat Support System-Army (GCSS-Army) or other authorized systems. Conduct defensive cyber operations (DCO) to protect Army networks, systems, and data from adversarial threats. Monitor, detect, and respond to cyber incidents using advanced tools and techniques. Perform other duties as assigned, including assisting with personnel actions, readiness reporting, and unit supply.

If not not already MOSQ applicants must be willing to reclass. The Cyber Operations Specialist course phase 1 is 36 weeks of virtual training and phase 2 is 12 weeks in person at the school house.

-Must be eligible for a Top Secret (TS) security clearance with Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) access.

-No ETP available for the above criteria.
