Must be a current member of the CO National Guard within the grade(s) of E6 and E6.

**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** This position is open to the grades of E6.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING:** The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Security Clearance Verification Memo
3. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS and service members with DOR less than 5 years).
4. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
5. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
6. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPPS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
7. Soldier Talent Profile (STP)
8. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
10. Exception to Policy (ETP) memo for AGR Soldiers who are under 36 months in their current assignment.

**POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

**The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 92Y**

**MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must already be 92Y MOS qualified OR have the ability to become 92Y MOS qualified within 12 months of hire.
2. Applicant must have current Secret security clearance and be eligible to obtain a Top Secret within 12 months of hire.
3. PCS funds subject to availability.
4. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. 5. Per the COARNG AGR Stabilization Policy dated 7 September 2025, AGR Soldiers serving less than 36 months in their current assignment are ineligible for application unless the announcement pertains to a promotion opportunity or an Exception to Policy Memo (ETP) is attached with application.

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Serves as the primary Non-Commissioned Officer responsible for both supply and mobilization, this individual plans, coordinates, and executes all Army Space Support Team (ARSST) deployment operations while also serving as the Commander's representative for all supply and equipment matters. This critical role ensures unit readiness for deployments and exercises by developing and maintaining deployment plans, acting as a key liaison between command and external agencies, and managing millions of dollars' worth of equipment through the Global Combat Support System-Army (GCSS-A). Key responsibilities include monitoring personnel and equipment readiness, coordinating logistical movements with joint and commercial partners, managing the Supply Discipline Program, performing maintenance on weapons and sensitive items, and initiating Financial Liability Investigations of Property Loss (FLIPL) to maintain full property accountability.

Must be able to obtain a TS-SCI and meet 40D requirements within a year of hire which includes: Completion of Space Basic Cadre Course (ASCBC), Tactical Space Operations Course (TSOC), Army Space Control Planner Course (ASCP), and Ground Missile Defense Staff Course (GMD) or T3 GMD Qualification Course.
