Must be a current member of the CO National Guard within the grade(s) of O2 and O3.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **O2 to O3**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Copy of Service School Academic Evaluation Report for MCCC (DA 1059) or ATRRS reservation for MCCC
3. Photocopy of last 3 OERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in OERS).
4. Certified Selection Board Copy of Officer Record Brief (ORB)
5. DA 5016 from My Retirement Points tile on IPPS-A or most recent NGB 23A (RPAM) from iPERMS
6. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
7. Security Clearance Verification Memo
8. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
9. Report from ATIS showing passing AFT and Height/Weight within the last six months (DA 705 and DA 5500/5501 accepted in lieu of ATIS report)
10. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) dated within 3 months.
11. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
12. Exception to Policy (ETP) memo for current COARNG AGR Soldiers who are under 36 months in their current assignment. Does not apply for promotion, Commander, or 1SG announcements

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 11A

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must become 11A qualified within 12 months of hire.
2. Must be MCCC complete or currently enrolled, post-company command
3. Additional staff experience, particularly in operations, preferred
4. Must have current Secret Clearance
5. Current AGR Soldiers within the 36 month stabilization period must include an exception to policy memo approved through the MACOM with the application.
6. PCS funds subject to availability.
7. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Assistant Operations Officer for a Mountain Infantry Battalion, responsible for preparing, coordinating, distributing operations plans, concept plans, and operations orders. Conducts mission analysis of higher headquarters plans and orders, and reviews subordinate supporting plans and orders. Coordinates and synchronizes warfighting functions in all plans and orders. In support of the S3, uses Commander's Intent and Guidance to oversee operations beyond the scope of the current order, develops plans, orders, branches and sequels, conducts military deception planning, develops policies, SOPs and other coordinating or directive products.
