WHO MAY APPLY:

Must be a current member of the National Guard within the grade(s) of E5 and E6.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **E5 to E6**.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING:** The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
3. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
4. Certified Selection Board Copy Enlisted Record Brief (ERB)
5. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS). If the Service Member doesn't have 5 NCOERs, provide 3 letters of recommendation .
6. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
7. Security Clearance Verification Memo
8. DA 705 with passing record ACFT score and HT/WT annotated. IAW NGB PPOM 22-023, individuals applying for AGR positions will require a passing record ACFT within 6 months of their packet submission.
9. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards.
10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 15T

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be 15T MOS qualified.
2. Must possess ASI B3.
3. Position requires applicant to pass Class 3 Flight Physical IAW AR 40-501 and Aeromedical Policy Letters.
4. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
5. IAW AR 600-8-19 Current AGR Soldiers must have 18 Months in their current assignment if they were promoted to be eligible to apply for the lateral assignment.
6. Required to maintain flight status.
7. Must be able to possess a SECRET clearance
8. PCS funds subject to availability.
9. All application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsmcs.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed, make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Performs and/or supervises inspections, repairs and maintenance according to drawings, blueprints, directives, technical manuals, and safety procedures (excluding repair of armament, avionics, electrical and cryptographic equipment/system components) to include the lubrication of required components and the removal and installation of aircraft subsystems, using special tools and equipment as required. Prepares aircraft related maintenance forms and records. Performs non-rated crewmember duties as a Crew Chief. Select Soldiers perform nonrated crewmember duties on the aircraft that are essential to its operation and or specific flight mission. Evaluates maintenance operations and facilities for compliance with directives, technical manuals, work standards, safety procedures, and operational policies. Performs maintenance trend analysis and applies production control, quality control and other maintenance management principles and procedures to airplane maintenance operations. Plans, conducts and supervises aircraft technical inspections. Computes basic weight and balance records. Participates in maintenance test flights. Ensure compliance with aircraft configuration control, Army Oil Analysis Program, and test measuring diagnostic calibration. Conducts flight and academic instruction in accordance with Aircrew Training Program (ATP).
