WHO MAY APPLY:
Must be a current member of the CO National Guard within the grade(s) of E4 and E5.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **E4 to E5**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Certified Selection Board Copy Enlisted Record Brief (ERB)
3. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in NCOERS). If the Service Member doesn't have 5 NCOERs, provide 3 letters of recommendation .
4. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
5. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
6. DA 759-1 Individual Flight Record and Flight Certificate
7. Security Verification Memo.
8. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
9. DA 705 with HT/WT annotated(last 3 APFT annotated). IAW HQDA EXORD 164-20, during the COVID-19 mitigation measures, all current valid passing APFT scores remain valid until further notice.
10. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards. IAW HQDA EXORD 164-20, during the COVID-19 mitigation measures, all current HT/WT remain valid until further notice.
11. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:
The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 15T

- MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:
1. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
 2. Must be 15 Series qualified
 3. Must become 15T MOS qualified within 12 months of hire.
 4. Required to maintain flight status.
 5. Must be able to possess a SECRET clearance

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:
Open to 15 Series MOS. Must obtain SQI of "F" - Flight Status
Knowledge of UH-60 aircraft systems preferred. A minimum of 24 months aircraft maintenance experience. Required to maintain flight status.Experience maintaining the UH-60 helicopter at unit level. Must have computer skills. Applicant should possess superior interpersonal skills. Applicant must be able to pass Class 3 Flight Physical IAW AR 40-501 and Aeromedical Policy Letters. Lakota Experience preferred.

Major duties: The UH-60 helicopter repairer supervises, and performs maintenance on UH-60 helicopters in all Army components. Duties for MOS 15T at each level of skill are:
MOSC 15T10. Performs and installs aircraft subsystem assemblies such as engines, rotors, gearboxes, transmissions, mechanical flight controls and their components. Services and lubricates aircraft and subsystems. Prepare aircraft for inspections and maintenance checks. Performs scheduled inspections and assists in performing special inspections. Performs limited maintenance operational checks and assists in diagnosing and troubleshooting aircraft subsystems using special tools and equipment as required. Uses and performs operator maintenance on tools, special tools and aircraft ground support equipment. Prepare forms and records related to aircraft maintenance. Perform air crewmember duties.MOSC 15T20. Performs duties described in paragraph (1) and provides technical guidance to subordinate personnel. Perform operational checks and scheduled

inspections. Diagnoses and troubleshoots malfunctions in aircraft subsystems.
