AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open to the grades of: E6-E7. Applicants must be eligible for a TS/SCI clearance; E-7s must be SLC complete and possess MOS 35N; E-6s must be ALC complete in any MOS. Applicants must attend airborne school within one year of selection for this position or one year after graduating the 35N MOS course (if necessary). Applicants possessing any of the following will be given hiring preference: MOS 35N, Airborne qualified, demonstrated training or experience with Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), SLC completion, an open T5 investigation, an adjudicated TS/SCI clearance, scores of 70 points or higher in each event on last APFT (ABN standard).

APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION

Qualified applicants must submit applications as described below to their current unit. Unit must provide and forward to the address in the Unit of Activity of this announcement. Applications received after 1700Hrs (MST) on the closing date will not be considered.

- 1. Memo stating why you should be considered for this position, including previous assignments and accomplishments. Please include a good mailing address and contact phone #. Do not exceed 2 pages.
- 2. PHYSICAL: Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with last Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) within 12 months of closing
- 3. date of announcement and HIV test less than 24 months old within 30 days after closing date.
- 4. Photocopy of last 5 NCOERs (memo required for gaps in NCOERs).
- 5. DA Photograph in Class A military uniform (ASU), three-quarter or full length, I/A/W regulatory timeliness.
- 6. Certified true copy of ERB with ASVAB scores annotated.
- 7. Copy of latest **APFT** Scorecard (DA 705) (must be less than 12 months old).
 - Profiles must be attached, if applicable. Temporary profiles will be accepted on a case by case basis.
- 8. Copy of current RCAS APFT and HT/WT History (minimum 3 years)
 - Must have a DD 5500 or 5501-R (Female) attach if body fat content test required.
- 9. NGB 23, NGB 23b (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard only)
- 10. Copy of current Driver's License
- 11. Soldiers that are flagged will NOT be considered.

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration. Applications will be submitted to the Office and Address listed in the upper left hand corner. Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. After recommendation is approved the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation

Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. M-Day Soldiers selected to fill a vacant position, may be assigned to that position and may be promoted provided the Soldier is on a valid EPS list and meet all the promotion eligibility requirements. After recommendation is approved by the G1, the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation. Technicians must verify with the HRO for job compatibility.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The signals intelligence analyst supervises and performs analysis and reporting of intercepted foreign communications and non-communications at all echelons. Assist in the collection management process. Gathers, sorts, and scans intercepted messages to isolate valid intelligence. Performs initial analysis to establish target identification and operational patterns; identifies, reports, and maintains Signals Intelligence (SIGINT) and Electronic Order of Battle (EOB) information in support of OB; uses technical references to analyze communications and non-communications information. Operate automated data processing (ADP) equipment for SIGINT collection, processing and reporting. Maintain analytical working aids and databases to support target collection, identification, and location. Perform operator maintenance on surveillance systems, organic communications equipment, light wheeled vehicles and power sources. Assists in the emplacement, camouflage, and recovery of surveillance systems and/or associated equipment. Prepare technical and tactical intelligence reporting.

Minimum Eliqibility Criteria:

Must be an E-6 or E-7; must be eligible for a TS/SCI clearance; applicants in the grade of E-7 must have MOS 35N and SLC. Must become Airborne qualified within 12 months; must not currently possess a permanent profile which prevents being on jump status.
