AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open to current eligible M-Day members and those able to join the Colorado Army National Guard in the grade of E6 through E7 that hold a 15U or 15T series MOS. Current NCOES and SSD complete for grade. Soldiers must either currently hold or be eligible to obtain a Secret security clearance within 1 year of accepting the position. All applicants MUST meet Chapter 4 Class A physical standards, and have a current flight physical by closing date IAW NGR 40-501 and AR 40-501. Applicants must have 36 months remaining on enlistment contract or be willing to extend.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION

- 1. Letter to the Board stating why you should be considered for this position including previous assignments and accomplishments. Please include a good mailing address and contact phone number. Do not exceed two pages.
- 2. Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with last Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) within 12 months of closing date of announcement and HIV test less than 24 months old within 30 days after closing date.
- 3. Copy of last 5 NCOERs (memo required for gaps in NCOERs).
- 4. Validated Selection Board Record Brief within 30 days after closing date.
- 5. Copy of record scorecard DA 705 (must be within less than 12 months IAW current guidance). Profiles must be attached, if applicable. Temporary profiles will be accepted on a case-by-case basis.
- 6. Must have a DD 5500 (Male) or 5501-R (Female) attached if body fat content test required IAW current guidance.
- 7. NGB 23B (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard only).
- 8. Copy of current Driver's License.

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration.

Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. M-Day Soldiers selected to fill a vacant position may be promoted provided the Soldier is on a valid EPS list and meet all the promotion eligibility requirements. After recommendation is approved by the G1 the President of the Selection Board will contact all applicants to notify them of selection or non-selection. Technicians must verify with the HRO for job compatibility.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Supervises aircraft maintenance and technical inspection activities. Determines man-hours, personnel, parts and facility requirements to repair aircraft and associated equipment. Plans aircraft maintenance areas, component repair shops and facilities. Instructs subordinates in aircraft repair and technical inspection techniques and procedures according to directives, technical manuals, work standards and operational policies. Maintains supply economy and discipline. Supervises the technical training program. Prepares evaluations, special reports, and records pertaining to aircraft maintenance repair and related activities. Recommends and administers plans and policies. Conducts flight and academic instruction in accordance with the ATP. Soldier required to perform frequent and repetitive aerial flight(s) to include CMF 15 and doorgunner.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

Must have a 15U or 15T MOS and have a complete qualifying Class 4 flight physical examination for flight status as prescribed in AR 40-501. Have a passing ACFT IAW FM 7-22. Meet Height and Weight requirements IAW AR 600-9.
