AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open to current members of the Army National Guard in the grade of E-5 and E4 promotable. Applicants must hold 12Y MOS or be eligible to re-class within 12 months of assignment and be on a valid/current promotion list. Soldiers must either currently hold or be eligible to obtain a Top Secret with SCI clearance within one year of accepting the position. All applicants MUST meet Chapter 3 physical standards IAW NGR 40-501 and AR 40-501. Applicants must have a minimum of 24 months remaining on their enlistment contract or be willing to extend at the time of position acceptance.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION

1. PHYSICAL: Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with last Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) within 12 months of closing date of announcement and HIV test less than 24 months old within 30 days after closing date.
2. Last 3 NCOERs (if applicable, to include a memorandum explanation for any evaluation gaps).
3. Validated Selection Board Record Brief.
4. Copy of latest ACFT Scorecard (DA 705).
Profiles must be attached, if applicable. *Temporary profiles will be accepted on a case by case basis.*
5. Must have a DD 5500 (Male) or 5501-R (Female) attached if body fat content test required IAW COVID guidance.
6. NGB 23b (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard only).
7. Copy of current Driver's License.
8. Soldiers who are flagged will NOT be considered.
9. Consolidate documents into a single PDF file.

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration.

Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. M-Day Soldiers selected to fill a vacant position, may be assigned to that position and may be promoted provided the Soldier is on a valid EPS list and meet all the promotion eligibility requirements. After recommendation is approved by the G1, the President of the Selection Board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation. Technicians must verify with the HRO for job compatibility.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Geospatial engineers are responsible for using geographic data which supports military/civilian operations for Disaster Relief and Homeland Security. They collect, analyze and distribute geospatial information to represent the terrain and its possible effects. Geospatial engineers extract geographic data from satellite imagery, aerial photography and field reconnaissance; create geographic data and compile them into maps; helps commanders and staff officers visualize the battlefield and advises them on topographic operations and special map product planning, create and maintain multiple geospatial databases and prepare military-style briefs covering all aspects of the terrain. The geospatial engineer accomplishes these tasks while staying current in basic Soldiering skills, which is necessary for today's battlefield.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

Must meet requirements as stated in the "Area of Consideration". Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions.
