WHO MAY APPLY:
 Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of CO within the grade(s) of E6.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of E6.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. Photocopy of last 5 OERs/NCOERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs/NCOERs and Service Members with DOR less than 5 years).
2. Certified Selection Board Copy of Soldier Record Brief (SRB)
3. DA 705 with Ht/Wt annotated. Must be current within the last 12 months, or six months if a current AGR.
4. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards.
5. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
6. Security Verification Memo.
7. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 00F3

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have or be able to obtain "R" ASI within 12 months of hire.
2. Must be able to obtain a SECRET clearance within 12 months of hire.
3. This is a Category 1 AGR position. Category 1 positions are fenced and cannot be moved or transferred outside the unit assigned.
4. Applicants must be willing to relocate within a 60 minute commute to Buckley AFB. PCS funds subject to availability.
5. Individual and collective team training investment mandates that assignment/selection to WMD-CST requires a minimum three-year tour.
6. Prior to placement a completed health physical IAW AR 40-501 Chap. 5 (Airborne) or CST OSHA Occupational Health Physical will be required if selected for the position. 7. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.
8. Current AGR Soldiers within the 24 month stabilization period must include an exception to policy memo approved through the MACOM with the application. PCS funds subject to availability.
9. During the COVID-19 mitigation measures ALL application packets must be submitted online @ <https://ftsms.ngb.army.mil/Protected/Jobs>. Emailed packets will not be accepted, unless the applicant is deployed. If applicant is deployed make sure you annotate on subject line of email (DEPLOYED) name and announcement number. BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

The WMD CST is a mix of Air National Guard and Army National Guard personnel. The team is currently responsible for both state and national level response. Hazardous materials response training is highly desirable. Applicants should possess a high degree of fitness and physical stamina in order to perform extended operations in heavy protective gear.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Assistant Operations NCO assists the WMD CST Senior operations staff in deploying a CST. Enables the WMD CST to conduct domestic CBRN operations through manning of a technical decontamination corridor. This includes; maintaining hazard monitoring equipment and decontamination specific equipment, establishing a decontamination reduction corridor on site, advising on the appropriate decontamination materials and techniques, and processing personnel through the decontamination reduction corridor. Conducts garrison operational and training duties. This includes maintaining training records for the WMD CST, coordinating all training requirements (individual and unit level), updating and tracking unit readiness. Member will respond to suspected terrorist attacks using Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) and production or storage sites involving chemical, biological, and radiological materials. Will serve in a two person team specifically charged to perform reconnaissance or sampling. Team members will assist first responders in the presumptive identification of hazardous materials. Survey Team members will perform reconnaissance of possible hostile areas containing hazards that are high health risk. Members are expected to obtain advanced proficiency in chemical, biological, and radiological concepts. Members must be or be able to become Hazmat Technician certified under civilian NFPA 472 standards. Applicants must possess or be able to attain a DOD Secret clearance. This position requires an above average amount of TDU due to high operations tempo and training requirements.

Applicants must possess or be capable of maintaining a government travel card in good standing to support travel requirements. All team members are required to respond to a no -notice 60 minute recall to Buckley AFB at all times unless otherwise approved.
