Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of CO within the grade(s) of O3 and O3.

**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** This position is open to the grades of O3.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING:** The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
3. Certified Selection Board Copy of Officer Record Brief (ORB)
4. Security Clearance Verification Memo
5. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
6. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
7. DA 705 with HT/WT annotated(last 3 APFT annotated). IAW HQDA EXORD 164-20, all current valid passing APFT scores remain valid until further notice.
8. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
9. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
10. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards.

**POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

**The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 14A**

**MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Applicant must be 14A and T3 qualified.
2. Must be able to hold Top Secret security clearance with SCI.
3. Must have prior GMD Gunnery Tables I-VIII qualifications.
4. Previous Company Command preferred.
5. Must meet eligibility criteria in NGR 600-5 and AR 135-18, Tables 2-1, 2-2, and 2-3.
6. Meet medical standards IAW AR 40-501, Chapter 3.
7. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Serves as brigade-level Missile Defense Element (MDE) Current Operations Officer (COO) for the 100th Missile Defense Brigade, Ground-based Midcourse Defense (GMD). Supervises two non-commissioned officer crew members and their contribution to the ballistic missile fight. Responsible for sensor integration into the GMD tactics and procedures for day-to-day operations, crisis, and combat operations. Monitors automated system readiness and maintenance statuses to include the battalion-level Fire Direction Center (FDC), Fort Greely, AK. Participates in C2 simulations, tactical exercises (TACEXs), war games, ground and flight tests (GT/FTs), and other related exercises. Supports the planning and development of the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) requirements into Joint and MDA Joint Program Office (JPO) material development process and operations.
