Must be a current member of the CO National Guard within the grade(s) of O2 and O3.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of O2 to O3.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below **ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED** documents to be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. NGB 34-1 (dated 20131111) must be complete with original signature and memos (Must submit explanation memos for yes selections except for question #9 and #17).
2. Photocopy of last 3 OERs (must submit memorandums for gaps in OERS).
3. Certified Selection Board Copy of Officer Record Brief (ORB)
4. Security Clearance Verification Memo
5. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
6. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
7. DA 705 with passing record ACFT score and HT/WT annotated dated within the last 6 months.
8. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
9. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards.
10. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:
The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: O0A1

- MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:
1. Selectee must understand that individual and collective team training investments mandate that selection/assignment to the CST requires a minimum three year commitment.
 2. Must complete the Civil Support Skills Course (CSCC) within 12 months of hire.
 3. Applicants must be willing to relocate within a 60 minute commute to Buckley AFB. PCS funds subject to availability.
 4. Must possess a current Secret clearance.
 5.  7. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:
Perform duties as the Operations Officer/S-3 for the 8th WMD Civil Support Team. Responsible for leadership, training, and welfare of Soldiers assigned to the operations and communications sections. Is responsible for operating the Tactical Operations Center during real-world missions, coordinating the team's efforts with the Incident Commander and all subordinate and adjacent units. Plans collective training, coordinates team training with local, state, and federal law enforcement, and ensures that training is executed and evaluated. Is responsible for updating all team SOPs to ensure that they reflect the latest in team tactics and Incident Command Structure requirements. Regularly represents the Commander at local, state, and federal meetings for WMD related business and serves as the team's liaison for those agencies.
